

Emirates appoints Globe as GSA

EMIRATES SkyCargo has appointed Globe Air Cargo, part of the European Cargo Services group, as its general sales agent in Hungary. The airline currently operates a trucking service every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from Budapest to connect with its passenger and all-cargo flights from Vienna to Dubai. Its daily Boeing 777 flights can each carry up to 15 tons of cargo and Emirates also operates a Boeing 747 freighter service from Vienna to Dubai every Saturday offering a further 100 tons of capacity.

Globe Air Cargo in Hungary, won the contract through a competitive tender and expects to generate up to 800 tons of cargo per annum for the airline.
