

## ***Mexicana appoints Globe Air Cargo as GSA for London-Mexico City route***

Mexicana has appointed Globe Air Cargo as its exclusive general sales agent in the UK to market capacity on its new direct flights from London to Mexico City.

The Mexican airline launched twice-weekly flights from London Gatwick to Mexico City's Benito Juarez Airport on January 18th, using Boeing 767-200 aircraft.

The Thursday and Sunday departures each provide up to seven tonnes of cargo capacity. Next month the airline is due to increase frequencies on the route to four services a week with the introduction of Wednesday and Saturday operations.

The London-Mexico City route is the airline's first transatlantic service and its first venture into Europe.

Globe Air Cargo expects to generate some 1,500 tonnes of cargo per annum for the airline from the UK.

The airline's main destinations are Mexico City, Guadalajara, Cancun and Monterrey. Globe Air Cargo will also market an extensive choice of on-forwarding destinations, including Tijuana, Leon, Aguascalientes, Puerto Vallarta, Chihuahua, Villahermosa, San Jose Del Cabo, Acapulco, Merida, Veracruz and La Paz.

Other destinations, including San Pedro Sula, San Antonio and Guatamala, are available on request.

Mexicana was the country's first airline nearly ninety years ago, and now serves more than fifty destinations in Mexico, Europe, North, Central and South America with around 300 flights a day.
