

Qantas goes with Aero

AUSTRALIAN carrier Qantas has named Paris-based Aero Cargo International, part of the European Cargo Services (ECS) group, as its general sales agent in France.

The deal will see Aero Cargo market the freight capacity of the airline's daily B747-400 passenger flights from Frankfurt as well as its twice-weekly B747 freighter operations out of Liège and Frankfurt, services which route via Singapore into Australia.

Freight being carried on these flights can then feed into the Qantas route network across the whole Australasian region.

Aero Cargo director Adrien Thominet noted: "Today, with fast road transport connections to Belgium and Germany, we can now offer cargo customers

in France quick access to the Qantas Airways network."

He added: "Qantas serves many markets that we see as being more robust and less affected by the general downturn in the market."
